

Vande Bharat Mission Flights
Japan to India
(21st & 22nd June 2020)

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. How many flights are scheduled from Japan to India in the third phase of 'Mission Vande Bharat'?

Ans. At the moment, there are two Air India Repatriation Flights scheduled from Tokyo to India: the first will leave Tokyo for Mumbai on 21 June 2020. It will continue to Bengaluru, with Thiruvananthapuram as its final destination. The second Repatriation flight will leave Tokyo on 22 June 2020 for Delhi. It will continue to Chennai as its final destination.

Q. How do I register for the repatriation flights going to Mumbai / Bengaluru / Thiruvananthapuram / Delhi / Chennai?

Ans. Embassy of India will circulate the form to collect information of stranded Indian nationals in Japan (**who have not registered earlier**) with genuine compelling reasons to go back to India. The link to the form mentioned above is <https://forms.gle/PYcVxVGEK4iJvj6n7>. **It is reiterated that those who have registered earlier should not re-register.** Separate forms should be filled up for each member of a family who intend to travel back to India.

Q. Will domicile of a State be a criteria?

Ans. Largely, domicile of a State where the airport is located would be a criterion. In addition, Embassy of India will attempt to include non-domicile passengers as well, subject to the concurrence of all concerned stakeholders, including the concerned State Government(s).

Q. Where will I undergo institutional quarantine?

Ans. Each State government has an evolving list of quarantine facilities. One of such facilities will be allotted by the Government authorities for mandatory

institutional quarantine. Passengers arriving from overseas will NOT be allowed to travel domestically without completion of mandatory quarantine period.

Q. When will I be contacted for ticketing purposes?

Ans. It will be the endeavour of the Embassy of India in Tokyo to contact you as soon as possible. The process flow for ticketing purpose is given below:
